



Preschool Toiletry and Stationery Requirements – New Children

- Each child needs to bring toiletry and stationery requirements ONLY ONCE per year.
- Please hand these items to your child's teacher or other appointed person at the beginning of the first term or on the first day of school if your child starts during the school year.
- We try really hard to contain the spread of germs in school. Not only do we drill the children in the use and disposal of used tissues, but we also use face wipes instead of the facecloth system.

All Children	Box of pop-up tissues – 200 in a box	4 boxes
All Children	Anti-Bacterial face wipes – Wet Wipes or equivalent 72 in a pack	4 packs
All Children	Antiseptic liquid soap bottle – Sanex/Dettol/Protex or equivalent	4 bottles
All Children	A4 Bright coloured cardboard – 160 gm 50 sheets	1 pack
All Children	A4 Pastel coloured cardboard – 160 gm 50 sheets	1 pack
All Children	A4 Photocopy paper – Typek or Rotatrim 80 gm 500 sheets	1 ream
All Children	Glue stick – large, Bostick or Pritt	4 sticks
All Children	Prestik – large	1 only
All Children	Retractable Wax Crayons – 10 in a pack	1 pack
All Children	Triangular Coloured Pencils 12 pack	1 only
All Children	Small paper scissors – metal	1 only
All Children	Sun hats wide brimmed (NOT baseball type) marked with your child's name on – Hats stay at school and are sent home for washing periodically	2 only
Toddlers	Sunblock – minimum SPF 30	1 only
Toddlers	Bum wipes pack (only for children still in nappies/diapers)	2 packs
Preschool	Triangular thick pencil – 2B lead	3 only
Preschool	Coloured pencils – 12 in a pack	2 pack
Preschool	Eraser (white)	1 only
Preschool	2-holed metal sharpener	1 only
Preschool	Roll of Cellotape (that will fit into a dispenser)	1 only
Preschool	A4 sized, 72-page, feint lined exercise book, covered in plain brown paper with child's name on INSIDE cover	4 only
