Year 7: Middle School Online Stationery Requirements for 2024

All children bring their stationery and requirements **only once** per year. Please send these items to school with your child on the first day of school year. Should any items be used up or lost during the school year, especially books for writing in and pencils etc, you will be asked to supply more.

Children who care for and use items sparingly will have leftover items that may be re-used or filled up the next year (personal items will be returned at the end of every school year).

Laptop:

Your child will use a laptop every day. To make sure the laptop can be used for many years to come, here are some useful specifications to look out for when buying the laptop.

- Minimum 4GB meg RAM (memory).
- Sufficient hard drive capacity to save downloads and documents, 250GB should be enough
- 15-inch screen size
- Wi-Fi connectivity
- Microphone and speaker
- USB ports
- Earphones (comfortable ones)
- Own two-point plug or adaptor.
- There are certain features on the Think Digital platform which is not compatible with an I-Pad. If you child already has an I-Oad, please make provision that there is a Windows laptop available for them to bring when they are writing exams.

Workbooks and writing books

Middle school children may cover their books as they wish. Please keep cover pictures appropriate for school.

Personal Items like Stationery and Computers

Your child will use and be responsible for their own personal stationery and computer. Please ensure that these items are very clearly and permanently marked.

Clothing items

Please mark all clothing items clearly and permanently. Permanent and laundry markers wash off eventually. All children have the same or very similar clothing items, so it is important that they are easily identifiable. The lost property basket is emptied at the end of each term and unmarked clothes added to the school's second-hand donations. Please note that it is not the teacher's responsibility to find misplaced personal belongings, but your child's.

These form part of the communal supply and will be shared by all children. It is not necessary to mark them.
